
At its September 2011 session, the Judicial Conference approved an amendment to the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*, Volume 6, Chapter 3 § 320.50.10(d), realtime unedited transcript policy. The amendment eliminates the requirement that a litigant who orders realtime services must purchase a certified transcript (original or copy) of the same pages. Litigants may order a certified transcript, but they are not required to do so. This policy is adopted in the Southern District of Iowa effective January 1, 2012, and will apply at all proceedings held on or after that date. Per page transcript rates were not changed, and remain as listed below.

<b>ORDINARY TRANSCRIPT</b> (30 day) To be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.65	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>14-DAY TRANSCRIPT</b> (14 day) To be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.25	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>EXPEDITED TRANSCRIPT</b> (7 day) To be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.85	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>DAILY TRANSCRIPT</b> To be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>HOURLY TRANSCRIPT</b> A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>REALTIME TRANSCRIPT</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a by-product of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.	One feed, <sup>1</sup> \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page		

<sup>1</sup>A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
