

Public Administrative Order

Where previous counsel of record is unavailable, the Office of the Federal Public Defender shall contact the Clerk of Court for appointment of volunteer Criminal Justice Act panel attorneys to review cases pursuant to *Johnson v. United States*, 135 S.Ct. 2551 (2015). The United States Probation Office and the Clerk of Court are authorized, without further order, to provide to the Federal Defender's Office, and to CJA Counsel, records in their possession, including the Judgment, Statement of Reasons, and Presentence Report for purposes of determining eligibility for relief under *Johnson*.
