
IN THE MATTER OF  CENTRAL IOWA WATER TRAILS: DOWNTOWN DESIGN & ENGINEERING COMMITTEE	<b>ORDER</b>  Public Administrative Order  No. 19-AO- <u>2</u> -P

The General Services Administration is currently constructing a new United States Courthouse for the Southern District of Iowa in downtown Des Moines. The courthouse is being built on land adjacent to the Principal Riverwalk, a community asset allowing for public access to the area along the Des Moines river system.

A community group, Central Iowa Water Trails, has been formed to provide a region-wide approach to invigorating the use of Iowa's river resources. Central Iowa Water Trails has multiple committees addressing particular community needs. One committee, the Downtown Design & Engineering Committee, has been formed to lead a collaborative process resulting in the development and implementation of a downtown design that is inclusive of varying project goals and diverse community needs.

As a member of the Downtown Des Moines community with a new presence along the Principal Riverwalk, it is in the Court's interest to be represented as a member of this group. As such, the Court designates United States District Judge Rebecca Goodgame Ebinger as the Court's representative to the Central Iowa Water Trails: Downtown Design & Engineering Committee.
