
Public Administrative Order

No. 06 - AO - 5 - P

If a party appearing *pro se* desires the issuance of a subpoena, that party must file – at least 20 days before compliance with the subpoena is required – a witness list containing the name, address, and a brief statement of the expected testimony of each witness for whom a subpoena is desired, and a description of any documents the party intends to subpoena. It is within the court’s discretion to decline to order issuance of the subpoena if the stated testimony is not material or is repetitive, or if the subpoena is sought in bad faith or for the purpose of harassment.
