

**ORDER**  
Public Administrative Order  
No. 08-AO- 0006

The Court hereby establishes the following procedure for review of motions or other applications for early termination of Supervised Release, whether filed through counsel or *pro se*. Upon the filing of a motion, or upon notice by the Court of any other request, for early termination of Supervised Release, the designee of the United States Probation Office shall promptly file a Status Report, with a copy to the United States Attorney, advising of the general progress made by the supervisee, any violations or other problems encountered during the period of supervision, and whether in the opinion of the Probation Office the person has received the maximum benefits of supervision. With the approval of the Court, and upon a showing of good cause, the Status Report may be filed under seal. Within ten (10) days of the filing of the above Status Report, the United States Attorney shall file either a Resistance to the motion or application or a Notice of no resistance. Thereafter the Court will consider the motion or application.
