**ORDER** 

Public Administrative Order

No. 11 - AO - 1 - P

Occupants and visitors to a U.S. Courthouse have a right to expect that they will be secure while conducting their business, and that the experience of entering the Courthouse will be fair and equal to all. The entry to the Courthouse should reflect the dignity and importance of the work involved in delivering justice.

Effective immediately, any person who uses the front entrance to the U.S. Courthouse in Des Moines, Iowa, is subject to the standardized screening process implemented by the U.S. Marshals Service through the Court Security Officers. Employees or others who have been issued electronic access cards by the U.S. Marshals Service may use any of the alternate entrances to the Courthouse without additional screening.
