
To allow for more strict controls and audits of interpreter vouchers submitted for payment under the Criminal Justice Act, new procedures have been proposed by the Federal Public Defender's Office of the Northern and Southern Districts of Iowa. The primary changes to current procedures are:

1. Electronic submission of the CJA21 Voucher for Expert and Other Services to the Federal Public Defender's Office, which would then be forwarded to counsel for approval.
2. Waiver by this Court of the general requirement for an original signature by anyone except attorneys, to allow interpreters to submit the CJA21 using an electronic signature.
3. Notification to interpreters that using the electronic signature line constitutes a statement under penalty of perjury, just as if they had used a handwritten signature.

The new procedures as proposed are hereby adopted by the Southern District of Iowa, for implementation as soon as practicable by the Federal Public Defender's Office.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
