ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 14 - AO - 7

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa has received multiple pleadings and actions from federal inmate Young Yil Jo. These actions appear to be brought on behalf of others as well as Young Yil Jo without any indication of authority to file on behalf of the others. The pleadings are rambling and cannot be rationally analyzed by Court personnel. Young Yil Jo was not initially prosecuted criminally in this District, and he has not been housed in this District. The Court cannot discern any basis for jurisdiction or venue in the filings. Further, the Court is aware Young Yil Jo has made similar filings in other U.S. District Courts. Under these circumstances, the filings are an unnecessary and baseless burden on the Office of the Clerk of Court. Accordingly, the Clerk of Court is directed that **no further actions or pleadings from Young Yil Jo shall be accepted or filed in the Southern District of Iowa absent further order of the Court.**
