PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

No. 18-AO-0002-P

The District Court is authorized to collect fees from attorneys who seek admission to the bar, who wish remain in good standing, or appear pro hac vice.

Accordingly, the court directs the Clerk of Court to collect:

- (a) \$181.00 for original admission of an attorney to practice in this district (original admission fee) (\$181.00 is to be deposited into the United States Treasury), *see* Local Rule 83(c)ⁱ;
- (b) \$25.00 for annual renewal of an attorney's membership in the court's bar (local annual renewal fee) (\$25.00 is to be paid by March 1st of each year, beginning in 2019, and it is to be deposited into the court's Library Fund), *see* Local Rule 83(c)(4)ⁱⁱ;
- (c) \$100.00 for pro hac vice admission, effective October 1st, 2018, (local pro hac vice fee), (fee to be deposited into the court's Library Fund), *see* Local Rule 83(d).

ⁱ In the year that an attorney becomes a member of the bar in this district, such attorney is only required to pay the original admission fee, that is, no local annual renewal fee as set forth in (b) will be collected by the clerk of court in such year.

ⁱⁱ Prior to 2019, the Northern District of Iowa and the Southern District of Iowa collected a biannual fee of \$50.00. Pursuant to Local Rule 83(c)(4), an attorney who is a member of the bar in this district is required to pay a local annual renewal fee of \$25.00 to remain in good standing, and, if such attorney is also a member of the bar in the Northern District of Iowa, they are required to pay a separate local annual renewal fee of \$25.00 to remain in good standing.
