



IN THE MATTER OF PANDEMIC CAUSED JURY TRIAL CONTINUANCES	ORDER Public Administrative Order No. 20-AO-20-P

Pursuant to Public Administrative Order No. 20-AO-19-P, the court enters the following order:

All civil and criminal jury trials currently set in the Central Division (only) of the Southern District of Iowa from now until October 12, 2020 are continued pending further order. The postponement of these cases will be assessed again by the Court in early October to determine whether further postponement is appropriate. The time between the date of this administrative order and the new trial date shall be excluded from consideration of the Speedy Trial Act's requirement of a trial within seventy days from arraignment. Specifically, the Court finds that the ends of justice served by these continuances outweigh the best interests of the public and the defendants to a speedy trial. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).
