O R D E R

It has come to the attention of the Judges of this Court that the local rule requiring local counsel be obtained in all civil cases where an attorney involved is not a member of this bar and/or does not maintain an office for the conduct of business within this District, has created an apparently unfair situation with respect to lawyers practicing in the Quad-city area. The Court is informed that the Federal Court for Illinois does not impose similar restrictions on Davenport lawyers involved in lawsuits in the Rock Island Division of that Court. Therefore, in Order to establish some reciprocity within this geographical area,

IT IS ORDERED that from this date forth, any lawyer practicing in Rock Island, Illinois, or Moline, Illinois, will not be required to obtain local counsel under local rule 5(F) when they are involved in a case filed in the Davenport Division of this Court. Otherwise, this local rule shall remain in full force and effect.
